

Articles of Faith Quiz Game

These questions can be adapted to play in a variety of ways, but here's one way to play.

Divide the group into two teams.

Explain that there are 14 categories (General and each of the 13th Articles of Faith).

Each category has questions worth 1, 2, or 3 points. A correct answer earns the team those points. If the answer is incorrect, the other team has a chance to answer and get the points.

Play for a pre-determined number of rounds, or until all the questions have been answered.

General

- 1 Who wrote the Articles of Faith? (Joseph Smith)
- 2 In what book of scripture do we find the Articles of Faith? (Pearl of Great Price)
- 3 What are the Articles of Faith? (13 brief statements of some of the beliefs of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints written under divine inspiration by Joseph Smith)

First

- 1 How many personages are in the Godhead? (3)
- 2 Name the three members of the Godhead. (God the Eternal Father, Jesus Christ, the Holy Ghost)
- 3 Describe the type of body each member of the Godhead has. (God & Jesus – flesh and bone, Holy Ghost – spirit)

Second

- 1 For whose sins will men be punished? (their own)
- 2 What does it mean to sin? (to willfully disobey God)
- 3 What is the difference between a sin and a transgression? (sin is to do something that is inherently wrong – like murder. Transgression is to do something wrong because there is a law against it – for instance driving a car faster than the posted speed limit.)

Third

- 1 Who is our Savior? (Jesus Christ)
- 2 What does the third Article of Faith say we are to do to be saved? (obey the laws and ordinances of the gospel)
- 3 What does the Atonement of Jesus Christ mean? (The Atonement is the payment for sin that Jesus made for all man so that they would have the opportunity to be cleansed from those sins)

Fourth

- 1 What does baptism by “immersion” mean? (to be completely covered by water)
- 2 What can you do to keep the promises you made when you were baptized? (various)
- 3 Faith means to hope for things _____ (that are not seen, that are true)

Fifth

- 1 Name two people who have been called of God. (various)
- 2 To preach means to do what? (to teach the gospel of Jesus Christ)
- 3 Tell what we mean when we say “a man must be called of God”. (he must receive that calling from someone who has authority and the priesthood)

Sixth

- 1 Who is the prophet on the earth today?
- 2 The Church that Jesus organized when he lived on the earth is sometimes called _____ (the primitive church)
- 3 Evangelist is another word for _____ (patriarch).

Seventh

- 1 What do the words “and so forth” mean? (that there are other gifts of the spirit that are not listed)
- 2 Who may receive revelation for the whole earth? (the prophet)
- 3 Name three spiritual gifts and explain what they are. (various)

Eighth

- 1 Who was shown and translated the gold plates? (Joseph Smith)
- 2 What happened because the Bible was translated so many times? (errors and mistakes have crept in)
- 3 Which English translation of the Bible is the most correct? (King James Version)

Ninth

- 1 Name one thing God revealed long ago in Bible times. (various)
- 2 Name two things God has revealed to us in the latter days. (various)
- 3 What kinds of things will God reveal to his prophets? (various)

Tenth

- 1 The prophet Jacob, in the Old Testament, was given a new name by God. What was it? (Israel)
- 2 How many sons did Jacob have? (12)
- 3 Why were the Israelites scattered? (they were wicked and were conquered by other nations)

Eleventh

- 1 What is the complete name of our Church? (The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints)
- 2 Name three other churches. (various)
- 3 What does “the dictates of our conscience” mean? (according to what our conscience tells us)

Twelfth

- 1 What does “being subject to” mean? (being obligated to be obedient to)
- 2 Name three kinds of leaders we believe in being subject to. (various)
- 3 Why is it important that we follow our leaders and the law? (laws keep our countries orderly and safe and leaders need our support to keep the laws in place)

Thirteenth

- 1 To whom should we be good? (all men)
- 2 What are two ways you can show love for others? (various)
- 3 What does the word “endure” mean? (to keep doing the right thing for your whole life)
